Day 1: Monday, February 2nd, 2026

- 8:30 am – 5:00 pm 📄 Registration at the P.A.Y.S. Event Building

Mooring fee: \$20 per night

Optional Water Taxi to and from your boat to PAYS dock: \$3/pp/ride or \$25 unlimited pass/pp for all 6 days

- 8:30 am – 3:00 pm 🛒 Local Vending Market – shop, taste, and support local entrepreneurs (Maps supplied) - **Free activity**

Optional walking tour at 10:00 am lead by Ken Gussie -approximately 1 hour

Cost: \$25/pp

- 3:00 pm – 5:00pm 🤿 Snorkeling through Toucari Bay – discover vibrant reefs and marine life - **\$20/pp**

- 7:00 PM – 🍹 Water Night Party/ welcome reception – dive into the fun with music, drinks, and a mouth-watering meat feast at Seabird Bar & Grill which is on the beach within walking distance.

Day 2: Tuesday, February 3rd, 2026

Choice of:

A) • 9:00 am – 10:00 am –  Bwa Neff Waterfall Trail – begin your afternoon surrounded by towering trees and bird calls, then cool off in a crystal-clear jungle pool hidden deep in the rainforest.

Cost: \$ free activity

• 11:00 am – 12:30 pm –  Segment 13 Hike: Penville to Capuchin – journey across one of Dominica’s most breathtaking trails. Wind through dense rainforest canopies, breathe in the scent of wild orchids and blooming heliconias, and marvel at the island’s dramatic mountain ridges meeting the sea. Every step offers a living postcard of Dominica’s untouched beauty. **Note: This is a moderately difficult hike. Wear proper footwear.**

Cost: \$15/pp

2:00 pm - Dive into a delicious Creole Picnic at Cannar Historical Point – a cultural dining experience with a view.

Cost: \$10/pp

 Historical Visit to Cannar – Explore an important heritage site that reflects the ancient conflicts of Dominica’s ancestors, where the island’s history and spirit echo through the landscape.

Cost: it’s a free tour however a contribution can be given to the upkeep of the site

B) 8:00 am – 3:00 pm - Kalinago Heritage Experience – Step into the heart of Dominica’s living history as you journey into the Kalinago Territory. Discover the traditions of the island’s first people through hands-on workshops in basketweaving, cassava bread making and traditional dances. Hear ancient stories passed down through generations, visit model huts and see how natural resources are still used for everyday living. The highlight? A mouthwatering Kalinago feast prepared with authentic flavors and techniques preserved for centuries.

Cost: \$70/pp

Evening – Dinner ashore on your own at 1) Purple Turtle or 2) Bell Hall Beach Club (both within walking distance of PAYS dock - reservations required)

- 2) Water Taxi Service will be available from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm (VHS Ch 68) as needed to and from PAYS dock to vessels - \$3 per person per trip or \$25 per person for entire rally.
- 3) Advanced registration/sign up required for all scheduled activities and events no later than 5:00 pm on January 19, 2026, through the Salty Dawg Dominica Rendezvous Captains Page. Payment for your registered activities and events may be made by credit card upon arrival and check in at the PAYS dock in Dominica.
- 4) There will be a local breakfast available ashore every morning in the PAYS building starting at 700 am. Menu pricing. Pay by cash or with credit card.
- 5) Please be advised that its easier to obtain a week parks pass at \$12.00 us per person instead of paying at each site (site passes will be available at the office the day of registration
